

2018 Fee Schedule - International Students

IMPORTANT: While every effort will be made to minimise increases in fees, there is the potential for tuition and non-tuition fees to change during the student's course. On average fees will increase by 3% to 5% per annum. A portion of fees will be charged where students commence after the start of a study period.

New Students

Application Fee \$400 (Non-refundable)

Payment

There are two (2) billing periods in the academic year prior to the start of each semester. Fees are invoiced two (2) weeks prior to the start of the next study period and must be paid prior to the start of the study period.

Non-tuition Fees

Boarding

\$28,836 (\$14,418 per study period)

*Includes a GST component on food.

EAL Support (compulsory only if stated as a condition of enrolment)

\$2,215 per year charged with Semester 2 fees for the whole year.

Academic Support Program (compulsory only if stated as a condition of enrolment)

\$35.00 per group lesson or \$70.00 per individual lesson.

These fees are billed per annum at the start of Semester 2 or at other times as appropriate.

Uniforms

A price list for your son's year level may be obtained from Student Admissions.

Text Books and Stationery

Cost will vary depending on the student's year level and elective subjects chosen. Text book prices for each year level may be found on the Champion Books website www.champion.com.au or obtained from Student Admissions.

Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)

BBC collects this fee on behalf of the OSHC provider. It is subject to the refund policy of our provider, Medibank Private. The cost of a 12 month *Medibank Private OSHC Essentials Single* policy is currently \$551.00 (cost subject to change). This can be arranged by the College if requested and billed on first fee invoice after the student commences.

Elective Expenses

The following are examples of services offered or additional expenses not included as tuition and non-tuition fees because they are elective:

- Study and other enrichment tours offered from time to time.
- Private music or private tennis coaching tuition (prices available from Student Admissions)
- Some pre-season sports camps may attract an additional cost for high performance teams in each sport.
- For boarding students, personal spending money and costs for participation in recreational activities offered to boarding students is at the parent/s discretion.
- Boarding parents must take into consideration extra costs for accommodation and care during term holidays if the student is not returning home during vacations; and air travel to and from Australia.

Concessions

Sibling Discount

In the case of two or more brothers attending the College at the same time, a discount of 10% on tuition fees applies automatically to the younger brother(s).

Upon written application annually, a discount of 10% on tuition fees applies to students who have older siblings attending Somerville House, Clayfield College or Sunshine Coast Grammar School.
